## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Orientation

Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Graders are invited to our 4<sup>th</sup> Annual 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Orientation on Thursday, August, 2, from 8:45 AM to 12 Noon. This day will provide an orientation to BPMS, give students and parents the chance to meet teachers and other important staff, and learn about the campus, clubs, and sports. 6<sup>th</sup> graders will also receive their 6<sup>th</sup> grade T-Shirt. At the end of the day, parents can pick up their 6<sup>th</sup> graders' schedule and pay fees. Families who are unable to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Orientation on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, can attend the Secondary Registration Day on August 7<sup>th</sup>.

## Secondary Registration Day Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup> is the County-Wide Secondary Registration Day from 9AM-1PM & 5PM-7PM at BPMS. Parents/Guardians can come with students to pick up schedules, pay fees, and take a tour of the campus.



## TDAP - 7<sup>th</sup> Graders

All 7<sup>th</sup> Graders must have their TDAP shot up to date and bring proof of vaccination prior to entering school. Florida Certification of Immunization (DH 680 form) must be provided to the school nurse on August 7<sup>th</sup> and or prior to the first day of school. All Pasco County students are required to be fully immunized.

## Health Requirements & Clinic Information

All Pasco County Students are required to be fully immunized. Students who are missing required immunizations will be unable to receive their schedules Registration Day. On Registration Day, parents should complete and sign a medical emergency card listing any illnesses, medications, and emergency contact information.



Students are not allowed to carry ANY medications while at school. This includes prescription medications from health food stores. A student may carry an asthma inhaler with written permission from a doctor AND a parent. All other medications that are scheduled to be administered during school hours MUST be stored in the clinic along with a signed parental form. Medications must be in their original container with the label attached. Questions about health requirements, medications, and other health services may be directed to our school nurse, Ms. Laura Hauser.
